CAMP DESCRIPTIONS + DETAILS:

NEW ROCKERS

Ages: 6-9 years | Duration: 4 days | Skill Level: Beginner

New Rockers is our most popular introductory camp for young climbers. Campers spend 4 full days in the gym focusing on climbing, games, and fun! Our instructors focus on creating a supportive environment in which all campers feel challenged, excited and ready for more. Your camper will not only learn the fundamental skills and basics of indoor rock climbing, but they'll also be encouraged to build confidence, communication skills, responsibility, and teamwork with other campers.

ADVENTURE ROCK 1

Ages: 8-11 years | Duration: 5 days | Skill Level: Beginner

Adventure Rock 1 begins with 4 days in the gym, learning the fundamentals of climbing and belaying while also enjoying a mix of fun games and group activities. On the final day of camp, the group joins our professionally certified, outdoor guide staff for 1 DAY OUTSIDE, climbing on real rock at a local climbing area. Adventure Rock 1 is sure to be a summer camp adventure your child will never forget!

ADVENTURE ROCK 2

Ages: 9-12 years | Duration: 5 days | Skill Level: Beginner - Intermediate

Adventure Rock 2 is the next step for aspiring climbers! It begins with 2 days in the gym, where campers practice essential climbing skills in a fun, challenging, and supportive environment. On these days, our staff lead campers in games and exercises designed to help them learn climbing techniques, knot tying, belaying, buddy checks, clear

communication skills, responsibility, and teamwork. Campers then spend 2 DAYS OUTSIDE at local areas climbing on real rock with our professionally certified guides, before returning for a final day of climbing and fun activities in the gym.

ADVENTURE ROCK 3

Ages: 10-14 years | Duration: 5 days | Skill Level: Intermediate

Adventure Rock 3 starts with one day in the gym learning and refreshing climbing skills and getting to know each other. Instructors focus on teaching technical and communication skills including knot tying, buddy checks, and belaying. The next are spent outdoors, where campers will enjoy 3 DAYS CLIMBING OUTSIDE with our professionally certified outdoor guide staff at our outdoor climbing areas. On the final day, campers will be back in the gym for a day of climbing and activities to end the week.

ADVENTURE ROCK 4

Ages: 11-14 years | Duration: 5 days | Skill Level: Advanced + must know how to tie in and top-rope belay

Adventure Rock 4 emphasizes outdoor climbing and exploring the natural world. Climbers spend the first day in the gym where they will review belaying skills, climbing movement, communication, and teamwork. They will then spend the next 4 DAYS CLIMBING OUTSIDE with our professionally certified guides! With a focus on climbing, campers will get to enjoy a variety of our local outdoor climbing areas.

SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualified applicants must come from low income households. Climber status is considered "low income" if their family's taxable income for the preceding year does not exceed 150 percent of the poverty level amount (defined by the US Department of Education).

Application responses will not be shared publicly and recipients have the option to remain anonymous. Edgeworks' DEI Advisory Committee will be responsible for reviewing and awarding all scholarship applications.
